7293 SOVIET ATTACK HELICOPTER MI-24V/VP HIND E



Production of the combat helicopter Mi-24V started in 1976. This version was equipped with the radically new antitank missile system "Shturm-V" with guidance system "Raduga-Sh", capable of striking targets with the highest accuracy – more than 92%. In other words 9 or even 10 out of 10 discharged missiles hit their designed targets. The Mi-24V excelled its American counterpart, AH-1S Super Cobra in combat efficiency. From 1976 to 1986 about thousand Mi-24V were manufactured in the USSR. These helicopters saw action during the Afghanistan conflict as a part of the Soviet Armies. Many of them were exported in several countries allied with the USSR. Nowadays the Mi-24V is still the backbone of the Russian Army Aviation.

Su-33 is a Russian fourth-generation carrier-based air superiority fighter developed for the Russian Navy. The fighter officially entered service in summer of 1998: by that time it had already been improved for 9 years.

Compared with the prototype, the Su-33 has larger folding wings, up-to-date navigation equipment, higher thrust to weight ratio, increased weapons load, and is air refuelable. Due to these unchallenged advantages the Su-33 became the most powerful ship-based fighter in the world.

Actually it is in service with the Russian "Admiral Kuznetsov" heavy aviation cruiser.

The first serial Yak-3s were sent to the 91 st Fighter Aviation Regiment of the 2nd Air Army. Light and maneuverable Yak-3 quickly gained popularity and became a symbol of a Soviet Victory jet fighter just like the T-34 was a symbol of a Soviet tank.

The "Ferdinand" was a heavy tank destroyer used by German Wehrmacht Panzerjäger during World War II. It was built in small numbers in 1943 under the name Ferdinand, after its turret designed by Ferdinand Porsche which had originally been rejected in favor of the preferred design from Henschel, combined with tank hulls that had been produced for Tiger I tank requirement. With its extremely effective very thick armor and its massive 88mm gun it was a formidable opponent, which could hit enemy targets up to 2 Kilometers away. The Red Army's anti-tank weapons were powerless against the Ferdinand's abilities. The Ferdinand remained in service until the very end of the war, finishing it in Berlin. The popularity of this machine was so high among the Red Army that the name "Ferdinand", along with "Tiger", became a household name and was often applied to all heavy automatic control systems in Germany".

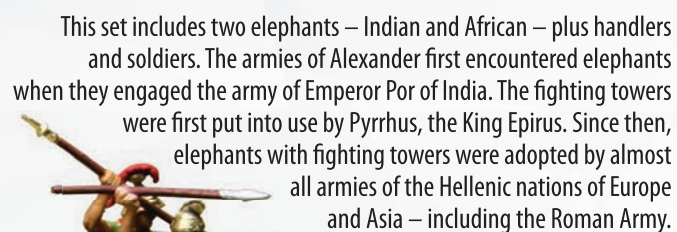
